MEET CONDITIONS

1. The competition is a Level 4 licensed meet, held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.
2. The competition is only open to members of Verulam Swimming Club.
3. The promoter is Clare Dale on behalf of Verulam Swimming Club.
4. The competition is open to all members of the club. Relevant times recorded are suitable for entry into County Championships and Meets at Level 3.
5. Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed swimmers in each age group. Points awarded in each age group are 1 point for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 3 for 3rd, 4 for 4th, 5 for 5th, 6 for 6th, 7 for any other placing, 8 for a disqualification and 10 for not entering or starting an event. Medals are to be kept by the swimmer. In the event of a tie for a medal, the higher place will be awarded to the swimmer who was fastest in the Individual Medley. Presentations will take place on the night.
6. The age groups for boys and girls are: Under 9years, 9/10yrs, 11/12years, 13/14 years, 15/16yrs, 17+years.
7. Age as at 1st July, 2017.
8. Swimmers should sign-in at 5:45pm ready for a 6:15pm warm-up. Events start at 6:45pm.
9. The pool is 25m and anti-wave devices will be in place. It is intended that AOE will be used.
10. Heats will be swum as mixed age with swimmers seeded by entry times.
11. Over the top starts may be used at the referee's discretion.
12. There are no upper or lower qualifying times.
13. Events are 25m all strokes for swimmers under 11 years and 50m all strokes for swimmers 11 years and older and 100m IM for swimmers 9 years and older. There are no finals. All events are timed finals. Swimmers are asked to choose to swim 100m IM and to order up to 4 their choice of 25m/50m events. The club aims to accommodate all entries for 100m IM and then the swimmer's first 3 choices of 25m/50m events. If, due to high number of entries this is not achievable, then the club aims to accommodate all entries for 100m IM and then the swimmer's first 2 choices of 25m/50m events. If the number of entries is low, then the club will accommodate all entries for 100m IM and then those swimmers who have chosen to swim all 4 25m/50m events.
14. Cost of entry is £5 per swimmer, regardless of the number of events swum. Entry forms should be submitted to your swimming coach or to a member of the committee by Friday 23rd June.
15. Results will be available on the club website and relevant results will be supplied to British Swimming for entry into the national ranking database.
16. In accordance with the ASA Child Safeguarding Policies and Procedures any parents or carers of swimmers under the age of 18 who wish to take photographic or video images are requested to focus on their own child as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in those images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends through social media platforms. Should you have any concerns about photography or filming at this event then please bring them to the attention of AnneTinkler (Child Welfare Officer) or Clare Dale (Meet Promoter). These policies will be vigorously enforced and any person found to be contravening them will be asked to leave the gala without refund.
17. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at Westminster Lodge. Neither the promoter nor Verulam Swimming Club will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
18. Entries to the meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998 to the holding of personal information on computer, will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoter.
19. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to ASA Laws, Regulations and the ASA Technical Rules of Racing.
